

# What you can do.

- Please try not to park on the street after a snowfall:
  - Parked vehicles impede the ability of the snowplow to clear the street effectively. The Village may prohibit parking temporarily to assist snow removal.
- Keep catch basins clear of snow and ice:
  - Catch basins must be cleared to accept water from snow melt.
- Keep fire hydrants clear of snow and other obstructions.
- Be winter ready:
  - Dress accordingly for any winter activities.
  - Ensure you have adequate winter tires and emergency kits.
  - During severe weather conditions, only go out if necessary and use public transit where possible.

## Snow & Ice Removal Guide



# Prepare

The Village's Public Works department monitors weather and road conditions 24/7.

Regular road patrols are conducted to inspect and assess road conditions during inclement weather.

Sanding and salting trucks are frequently used during this time to prevent snow or ice from bonding to the road.

If severe weather is forecasted, personnel and equipment are mobilized to provide 24 hour response.



# Priority Roads

Snow clearing, sanding and salting are conducted on a priority bases:

## Priority 1

Main Roads, Emergency & School Routes

## Priority 2

Secondary Roads

## Priority 3

Public Sidewalks in Commercial Areas

## Priority 4

Public Sidewalks on Lillooet Ave and Hot Springs Rd

# For Residents

Clearing driveways and entrances is the responsibility of the property owner. Property owners/occupants are asked to assist the Village and in consideration of fellow residents for clearing sidewalks adjacent to their properties. When clearing your driveway, pile the snow on the left side (as you look towards your house) of your driveway.

# For Businesses

We ask businesses to remove snow and ice from the sidewalk and footpath on the property no later than 10am.

After a snowfall or ice storm, snow and ice must be removed from the roof or any other structure where there is potential for ice and snow to fall on any sidewalk or roadway.
